## Safety, Bullying, and Harassment

- x There was feedback about the procedures for reporting bullying; women are concerned about the risk of retaliation and thus are reluctant to follow formal processes.
- x Discussion of HDR student experiences of sexual harassment and gender discriminations with concerns about how these complaints are handled.
- x Women asked to be included in decisionaking about design issues like lighting, access to parking, and security, particularly when buildings are being planned or refurbished.
